THAT John Bricker having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Two months from the First day of March 1836 until the _____ day of April 1836 and being honorably discharged from the Army by Death is entitled to nine hundred & sixty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said John Bricker is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

Survey for John Dricker (by W. W. Shippard his administrator) of 320 acres of land, situate on Peach creek, a branch of East San Jacinto, being the remainder of the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of a land warrant, No. 1349, dated 26th December, 1837. Beginning 1026 var. $S. 45^{\circ} E$ from South corner of C. Shaw survey - set post from which a white oak 34 in. dia. marked $\&$ bear $S. 43^{\circ} E$ 10 var. dist. and a white oak 20 in. dia. marked $\&$ bear $S. 41^{\circ} W$ $4\frac{1}{2}$ var. dist.

var. East Thence North $45^{\circ} E$ with Shaw survey
144 To Peach creek - 7 var. wide - course South East
1344 To West corner of Clark's survey - a stake from which a white oak 8 in. dia. marked $\&$ bear $S. 81^{\circ} W$ 3 var. dist. and a pine oak 24 in. dia. marked $\&$ bear $S. 16^{\circ} E$ 7 var. dist.

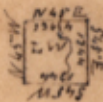
