## A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE CONROE, TEXAS POST OFFICE 1883-1980

It was not until forty-five years after the first post office was commissioned in Montgomery County that Isaac Conroe established a postal unit in his commissary, located at 202 Avenue A. Conroe, a sawmill operator, was the first postmaster of Conroe's Switch, Conroe's and later Conroe.

Montgomery, the first post office in the county, was established May 17, 1838 with W.W. Shepperd being appointed postmaster by the Republic of Texas.

Isaac Conroe, the city founder, served as postmaster from December 4, 1883 to April 24, 1893 and from June 17 to September 8, 1897, the day of his death.

Many loyal and dedicated people have served the Conroe post office during its 97-year history but it is not possible to tell their stories in a brief article. A detailed history of the Conroe post office is available at the Montgomery County Library. Restricted space allows only a list of postmasters, dates they served and various locations of post office buildings:
