TURNER CEMETERY Also known as Tree Monkey Road

About 12 miles west of Magnolia on FM 1488; left side of road going toward Hempstead.

The following information was given to the Wrights by mail, by Mr. & Mrs. Otis Turner, Sacramento, CA. 1979.

Three adult graves:

1. Robert Turner -2. Genora Henningan Turner - Died: 1915 3. George Edwin Turner - Died: 1918

Robert Turner was brother to George E. The Cude children's mother was Genette Cude, who was a twin to Genora Hennigan.

Infant & childrens graves: 3 infant graves - still-born Cude babies; father was Jim Cude. 3 infant graves - still-born Turner babies.

The following children died within a week or ten days ca 1909: Siney Cude, a girl about 4 or 5 years old. Florence Cude, a girl about 8 years old. Travis Cude, a girl about 5 years old.

Otis Turner is the 3rd child of Ed and Nora Turner. In 1979 he was 80 years old.

Nora Turner died in 1916. Ed Turned died in 1917. We do not know if they are buried in this cemetery.

Land for this cemetery was set a-side by J. C.(L.) Turner, recorded in Vol. 38, page 444, Abstract #296, Griffin Abstract.
