AFFIDAVIT OF DEDICATION FOR CEMETERY PURPOSES FOR THE CHINA GROVE CEMETERY

THE STATE OF TEXAS § KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY §

That the Texas Historical Commission, an agency of the State of Texas, does hereby certify and declare:

That the China Grove Cemetery, located in RESERVE "A", CHINA GROVE VILLAGE, SECTION ONE, CHINA GROVE SUBDIVISION, Montgomery County and previously filed and recorded in the Official Public Records of Montgomery County, Texas, in Vol. 45, Pgs. 170-171; Vol. 457, Pgs. 388-392; Document No. 718-10-2886; and more particularly described in Exhibit A as attached hereto, has been set aside and dedicated for cemetery purposes through historic use and that such property is now occupied by human graves.

That the Texas Historical Commission has duly considered the evidence of existence and historic use of said cemetery and has listed said cemetery as a Historic Texas Cemetery, worthy of preservation.

That this dedication is subject to all the laws, rules, and regulations of the State of Texas regarding cemeteries now in effect and to those adopted after the effective date of this dedication, and is made in accordance with 13 Tex. Admin. Code Section §21.30.

This Affidavit of Dedication for Cemetery Purposes is signed and executed on this 26th day of January, 2007.

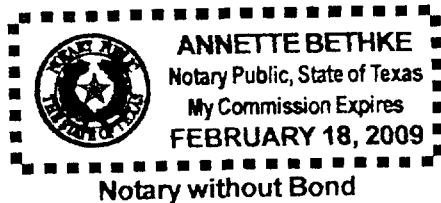

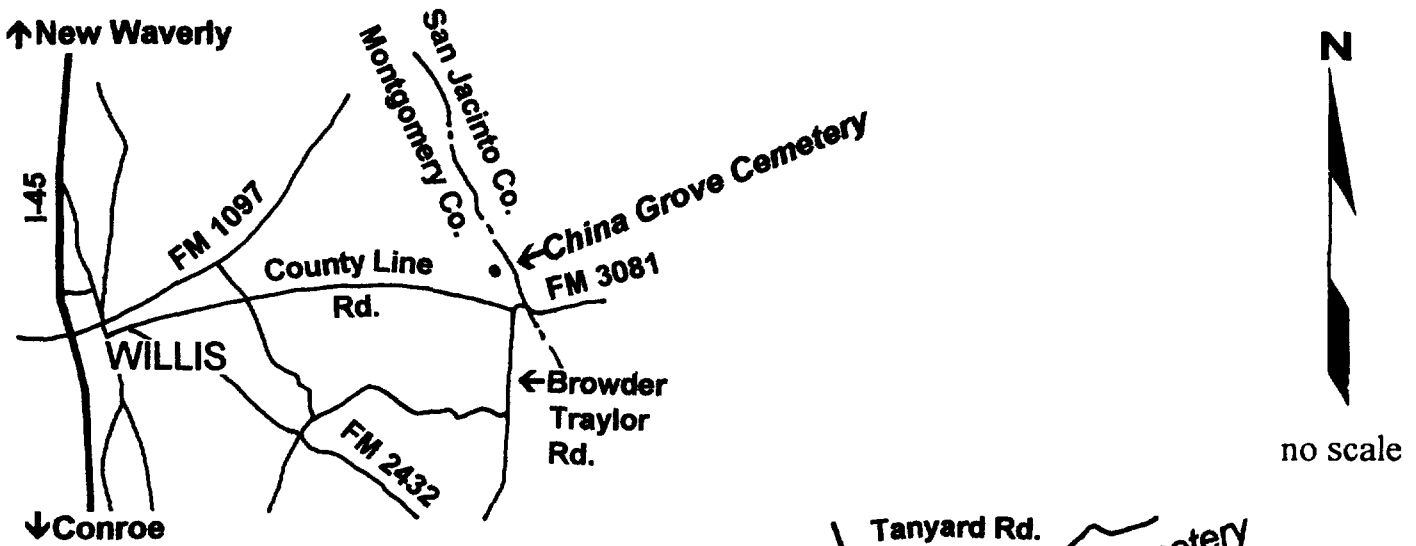

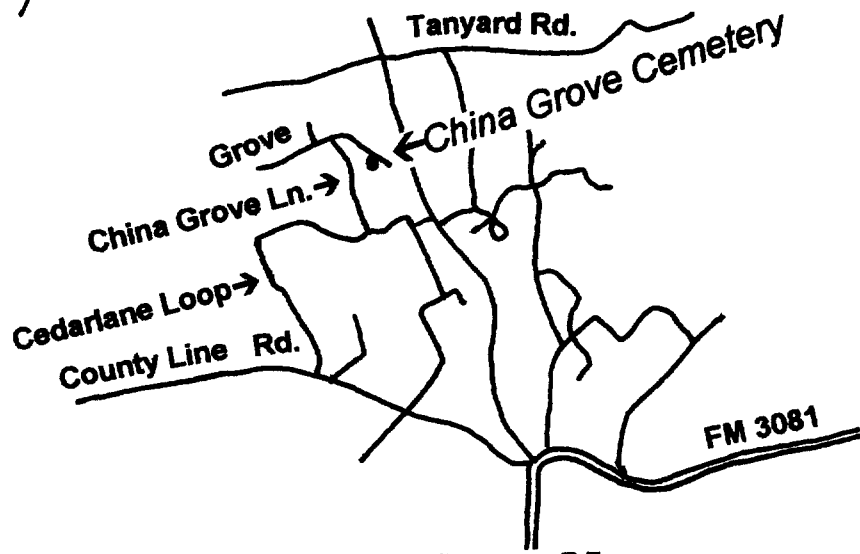

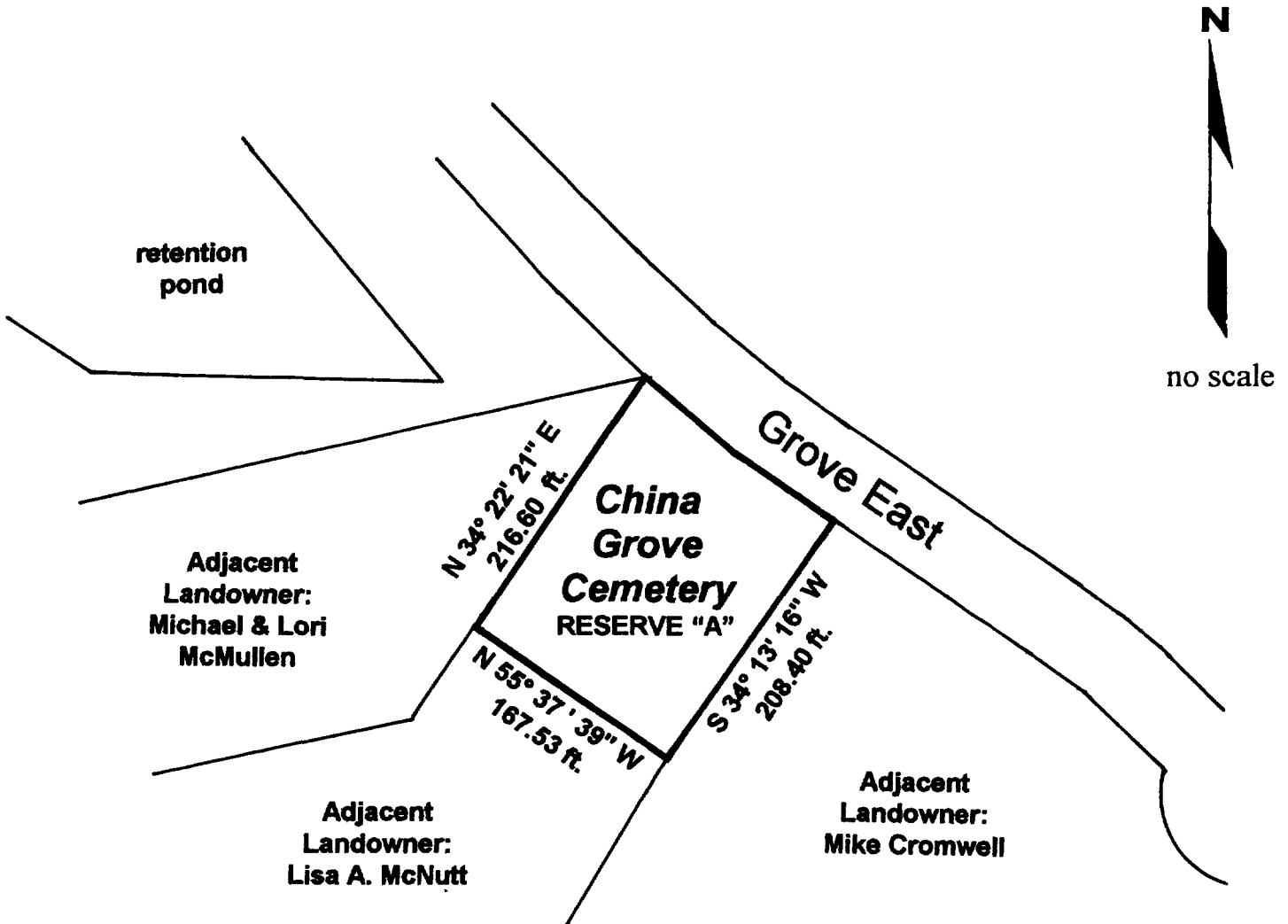
