He does by these presents, Grant,
Bargain, transfer, Sell, Convey and Deliver unto
Samuel Sawyer Littlefield of this city
present and accepting and who hereby acknowledges
possession thereof all his right, title and interests
in and to three Hundred & twenty acres of Public
Land situated in the Republic of Texas, being
accorded to him for three months military service
commencing on the Eighteenth day of May eighteen
hundred and thirty six and ending on the Eighth
day of August of the same Year as private in Captain
Hughes Company of Texas Volunteers, per
Certificate number Fifty Eight from George
W. Gos, acting Paymaster General dated the
Seventh day of September Eighteen hundred &
thirty six together with all the rights & privileges
appertaining to the same, and with full power
and authority to Exercise the rights thereof.

And for the fulfillment of all
Cases singular the aforesaid rights and privileges,
the said Duncan Mc Intyre hereby irrevocably
appoints & in his place and stead deposes
and puts the said Samuel Sawyer Littlefield
his Attorney in fact, with full power to make

Signe, and Execute in his name all acts whether of
Sales, release, assignment, Contract, Compromise, Covenant,
Quit, Bond, transfer, or otherwise and binds him thereby
as firmly as if the same were his proper acts & duties
& to seek, have, take, by all lawful means to
recover & receive of whom it may concern the lands
herein described, and to do all matters and things
touching the same that said Constituent could
