Förord. För att sätta bibelläsare bättre i stånd att så gära hafwa wi ansett oss böra taga ännu ett steg mot vårt föresatta mål genom att infoga i vår bibelupplaga efterföljande bibelkonfordans. Originalet till denna bok, som är utgifwet af ett sällskap i England för besträmmande af kristlig kunskap, har wunnit en förtäring i spridning. I England har denna konfordans utgått i hundratusentals exemplar, i de flida skandinaviska länderna har den upplemt flera upplagor, och här i Amerika hafwa wi redan haft den glädjen att sprida den i millioner exemplar. Det bör därför icke försummas något twifwel om värdet och pålitligheten af detta wert; och wi wåga på den grund uttala vår förwihning om, att den äfwen i den gestalt, hwari den nu framträder, skall wara till stor välfignelse för hwar och en, som älskar ett djupare inträngande i Guds Heliga ord.
