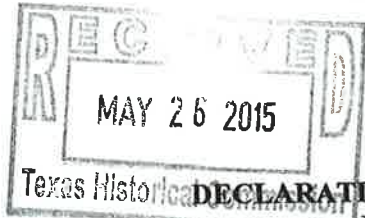

That the Barton Farm Cemetery, located in the , Unknown, Robertson County, Texas and more particularly described in Exhibit A as attached hereto, has been set aside and dedicated for cemetery purposes through historic use and that such property is now occupied by human graves.

That this dedication is subject to all the laws, rules, and regulations of the State of Texas regarding cemeteries now in effect and to those adopted after the effective date of this dedication, and is made in accordance with 13 Tex. Admin. Code Section §22.6.

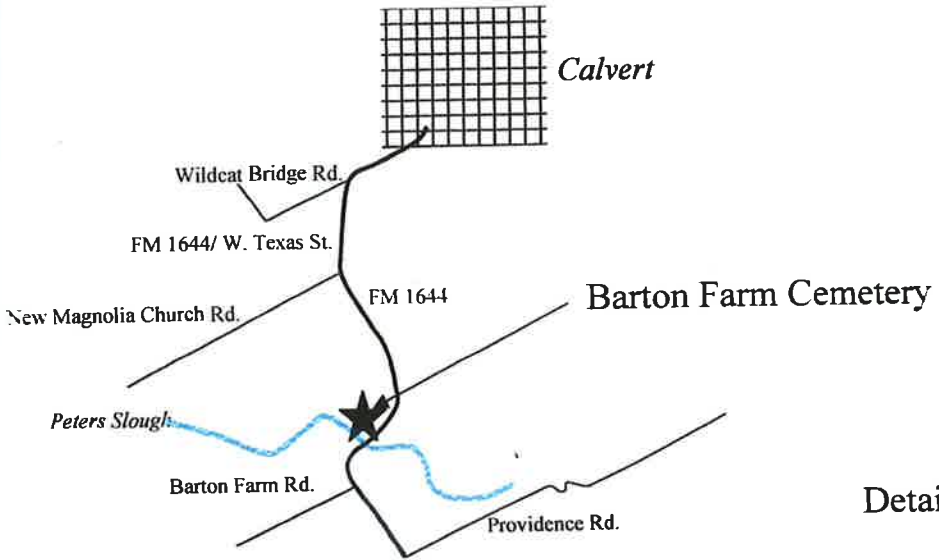

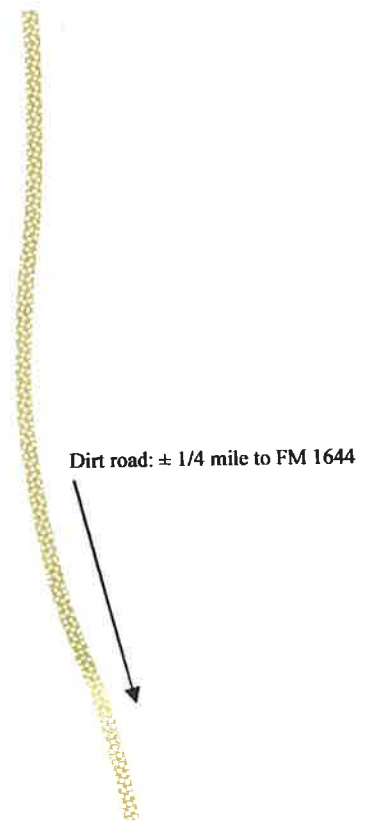
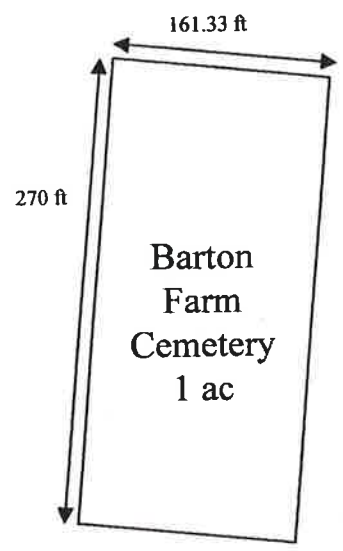
Location Map

Hill Survey, Abstract No. 166, and further being out of a 1094.27 acre tract described as TRACT 2 in a Deed to C. A. Skiles Family Partnership, LTD. recorded in Volume 1018, page 515 of the Deed Records of Robertson County, Texas, said tract or parcel of land further being the same tract of land being dedicated for the perpetual use as a grave yard in a Deed from W. C. Anderson to Mrs. Minnie W. Barton recorded in Volume 45, page 120 of the Deed Records of Robertson County, Texas, said tract actually located on the ground where grave sites exist and described as follows:

COMMENCING at a found 3/8" steel rod at a fence corner in the West line of F. M. Highway 1644 for the North East corner of the above mentioned 1094.27 acre tract;

THENCE S 11 deg 53' 39" W 2970.07 feet to a found 1/2" steel rod for the PLACE OF BEGINNING and for the North East corner of the herein described tract;

THENCE S 5 deg 00' 00" W 270.00 feet to a found 1/2" steel rod for the South East corner of the herein described tract;

THENCE N 85 deg 00' 00" W 161.33 feet to a found 1/2" steel rod for the South West corner of the herein described tract;

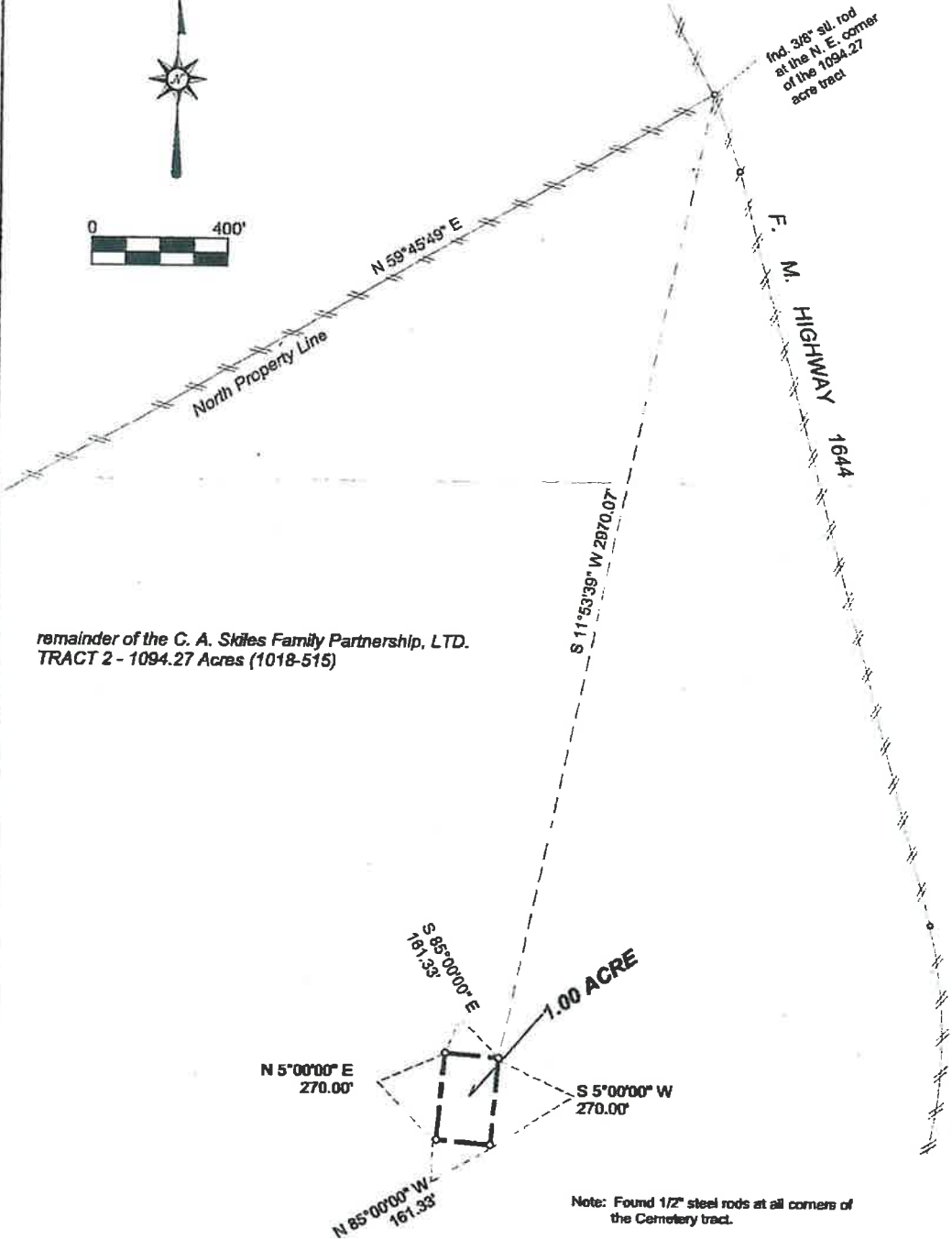
THENCE N 5 deg 00' 00" W 270.00 feet to a found 1/2" steel rod for the North West corner of the herein described tract;
