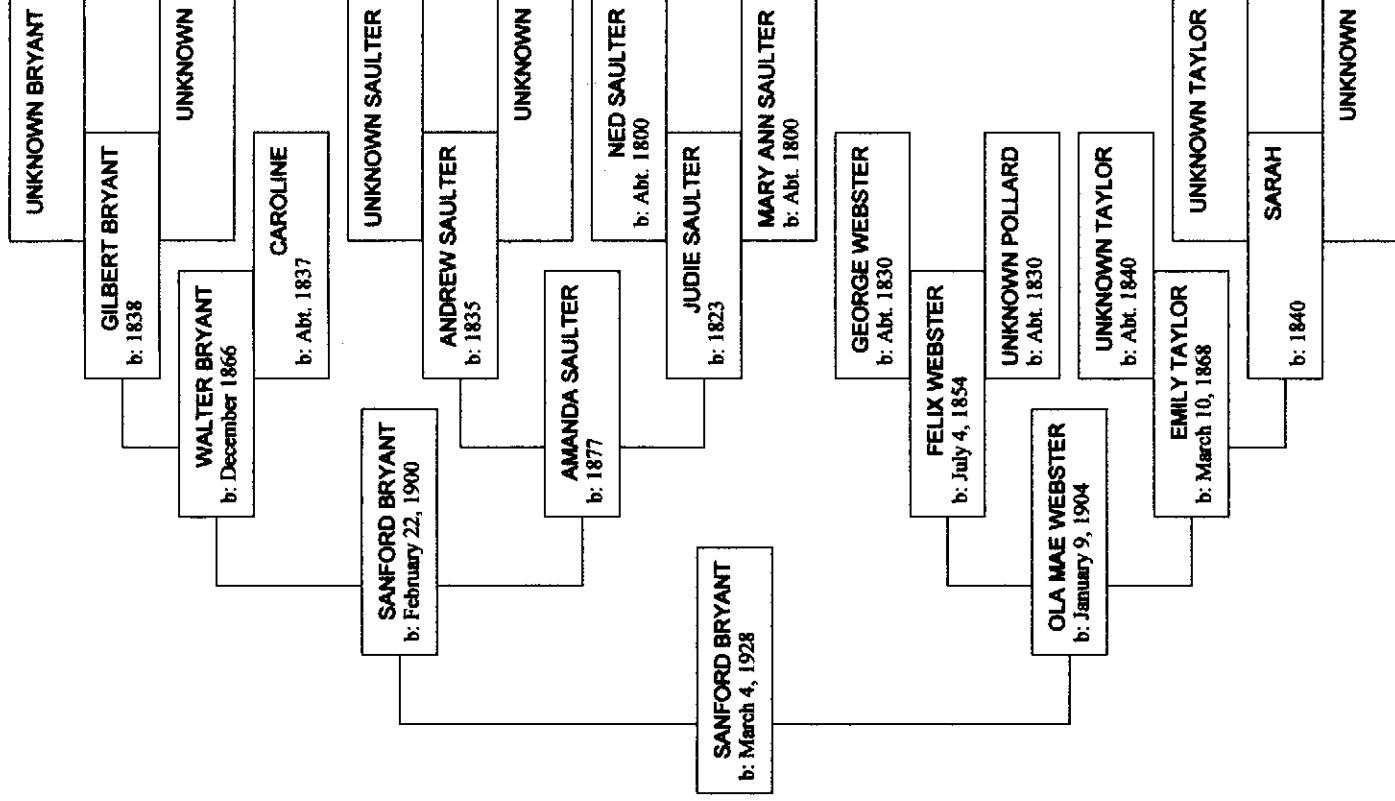
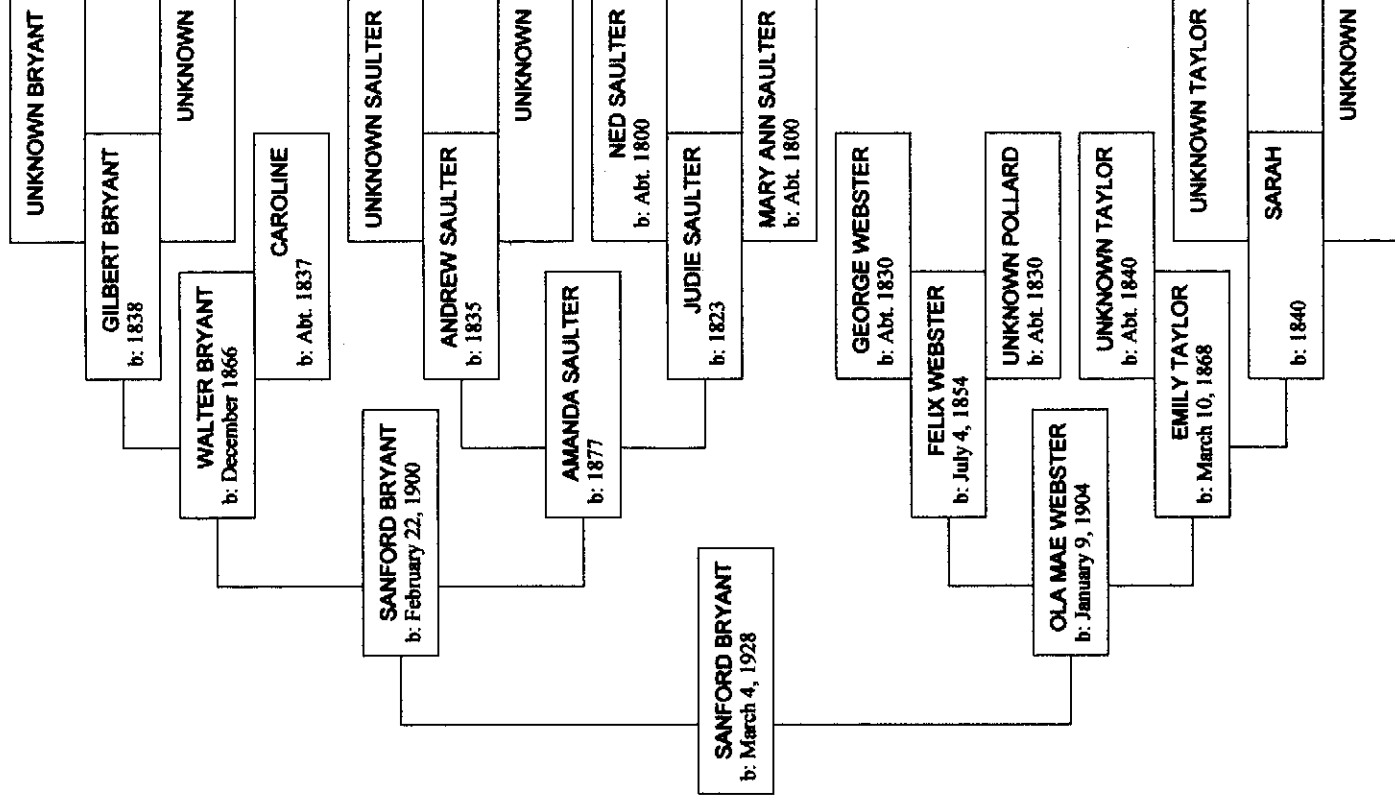

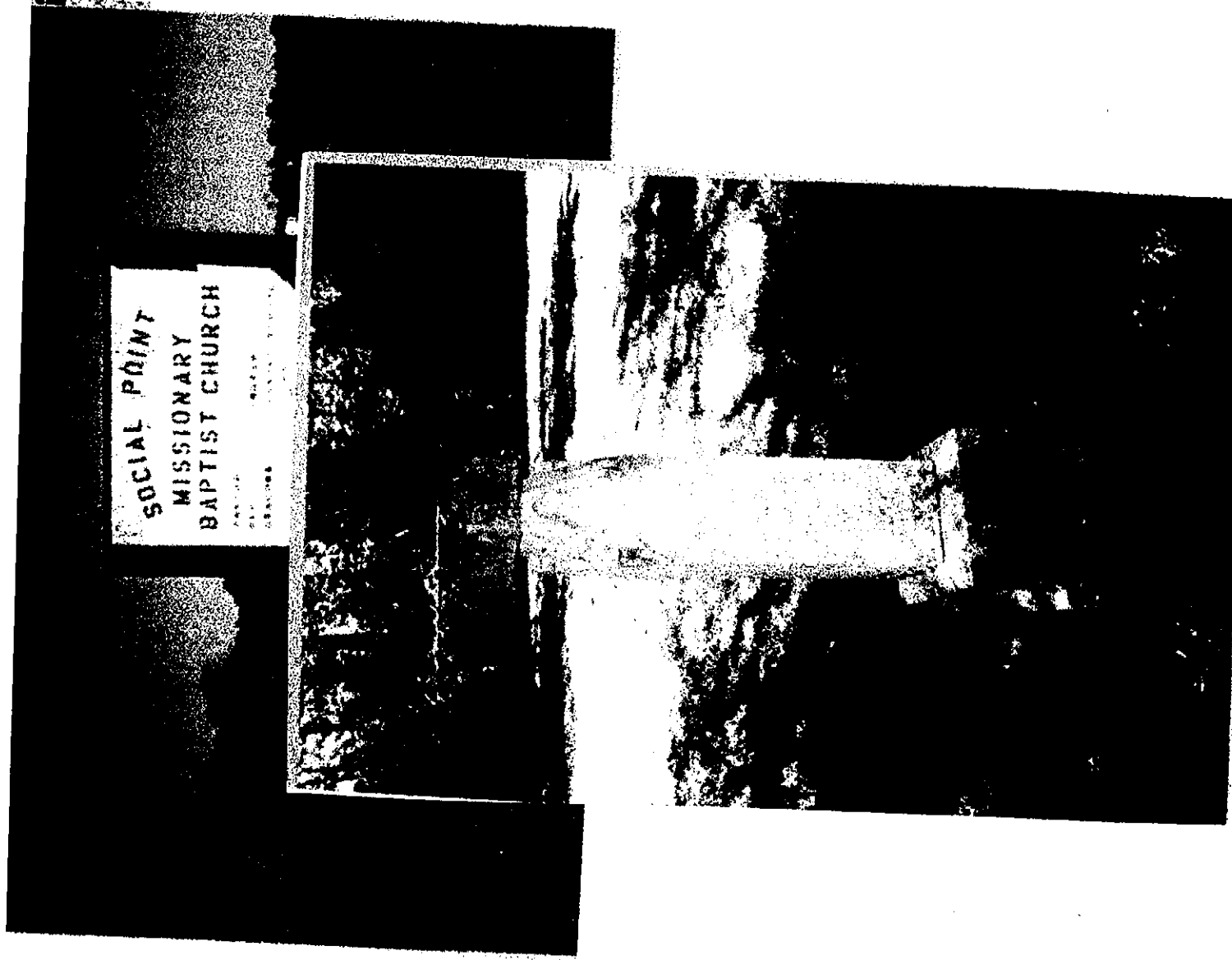

### ***Descendants of NED AND MARY ANN SAULTER***

Salter or Sautler the name is suppose to be spelled Sautler but most of the time is spelled Salter and even found as Salters or Selter. The Sautler family is rich in oral family history. The history of this family was carried through Judie Sautler who lived to the grand age of 110 years. You will find her death certificate included. It reads like a page from history. What a day it was when it arrived in the mail. It gives her parents names, Ned and Mary Ann and their birthplace as Rappahannock County Virginia along with Judie's birth date as 1823 birthplace Rappahannock County, Virginia. It is amazing how this name survived all those years. Amanda Sautler Bryant filled out the death certificate. Also, included in the appendix is a copy of the Sautler Family Reunion Newsletter. It also outlines this great family history. There is a picture of Anthony Salter the son of Judie and Andrew Sautler in the Sautler Family Reunion Newsletter 1991.

The Sautler history in the United States begins on a Plantation in "Old" Rappahannock County Virginia (see map). In Virginia the name would not have been Sautler. Some time after 1830 it is speculated a female member of the Plantation family married a Sautler and moved to Georgia. She was probably given slaves as a wedding present to take with her to Georgia (this was common practice). There are no Sautler Families listed in Virginia during the time of 1800 to 1830. There are Sautler families in Washington County Georgia in 1830. Thus Ned, Mary Ann, Judie and Ellen (there probably were other siblings) went to Georgia. By 1850 they were in Conecuh County Alabama. It was in Alabama that Judie met and married Andrew. They had one child in Alabama. They were owned by Jesse Salter ( B. Georgia) and Mary Ann Salter(B. Alabama). They had a son James D. Salter (B. Alabama). In 1859 James D. and his wife Elvira moved to Panola County Texas bringing with them Our Sautler Family. It was at this time that Judie's sister Ellen(possibly a twin) was sold and was taken to Florida. After this Judie wanted to be called Judie Ellen (see Sautler Family Reunion Newsletter). Also, Judie and Andrew named their first child born in Texas 1860 Alabama. I found the Sautler Family listed by age in the 1860 slave schedule for Panola County. Thus, begins the saga of the Sautler Family in east Texas. James D. Salter was followed by his brother, Thomas Jefferson Salter. He married Amanda Kyle. It would be on the grounds of the Kyle Place many years later that Sanford Bryant while working "a half of hand" would be killed.

## *Descendants of GILBERT BRYANT*

The information on the Bryant family in Texas was very sketchy. Ola Mae Webster Bryant provided the following information: Walter Bryant (she said he had been dead along time), West Indies (this info was abandoned early as it did not seem to make sense), married Amanda Salter in Panola County, they had five children. I found the marriage certificate for Walter and Amanda in Panola County, Texas Dec 25 1892. Of course the censuses were consulted but Amanda was never in the census with Walter. Barbara Bonner was consulted. She is an African-American Historian living in Panola County and related to the Bryant family of Panola County. No match was found. However, Barbara Bonner found a tombstone in Social Point Cemetery marked Walter Bryant 1907?. The mystery was deepening. I found a Walter Bryant listed in the city directory for Waco, McLennan County TX 1890-1891. It states that he lived at 600 south 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Corner of Clay. His occupation is laborer. Walter Bryant that could be found a birth date abt. 1866 was listed in the 1900 census for Walker County Texas Huntsville penitentiary. He is listed as from BEXAR County Texas and father from the West Indies and mother from Kentucky. This was amazing here were the West Indies popping up . . . such a small shard of evidence but so important. Next the 1880 census for Bexar County showed Walter was the son of Gilbert Bryant and Caroline. Gilbert was born in Indian Territory (what became Oklahoma), Gilbert's parents were both born in North Carolina. He was born the year the Trial of Tears ended. His parents made that fateful walk from the Carolinas. Thousands perished on this forced march and relocation. They were being driven out of the only home they knew by the United States Calvary. I looked at the federal census for Indian Territory for 1860 on line but it was incomplete. But the Bryant name was Cherokee. They were not enslaved Africans but Indians educated probably by missionaries. Gilbert and Walter could read and write. Gilbert is found in the 1880 and 1900 censuses. His wife in the 1900 census in Annie. They were married about 1880. Possibly Caroline died in childbirth. A Gilbert Bryant born 1880 is found in the 1910 census for Harrison County, TX. Next I checked out Bexar County. It turns out that Bexar County was the seat of the first civil government in Texas. It was founded by Spaniards from the Canary Islands (West Indies) by edict of the King of Spain. How could this figure in our puzzle? I wrote for the prison records. Walter Bryant is listed across complexion, eye color, and hair color categories as Copper. Did people assume he was from the West Indies because he was from Bexar? Was this better that being labeled Cherokee Indian? But the biggest puzzle is how he managed to have five children while serving a life sentence for rape (see documents that follow in an appendix). The children's birthday's are very close. Was Amanda given a yearly visit? This seems very unlikely. There last child was born 1906. Walter was murdered November 5, 1907. He died form a gunshot wound to the left hip.

### **A Conversation with Charlie Hooper as Told to Louise Martin 1998**

Charlie Hooper lived and was raised in Bobo, Texas. I asked him if he remembered Anthony Sautler and the following is what he told me.

Mr. Sautler had a brother Alex. Anthony was a Baptist preacher. He lived in a place called Social Point which is close to the Woods post office in Panola County. When he moved to Bobo he used to get up at 8am and walk to Social Point to attend Sunday School and church. He had a good voice and you could hear him sing all over the place. Anthony's first wife died while they were in Bobo but I can not remember her name. He then married Helen Mosley (Mosly or Mosby). She died before him and he was in his nineties. He was very tall and thin (skinny rawboned type). His children by his second wife were: Felix, CB, Oscar, Tempie, Euretta, and Charlsie Mae. He was always a sharecropper and never owned any property.

### **A Followup Conversation with Charlie Hooper Recollections of the Bryant Family**

Charlie Hooper stated that he was born in 1914. He attended Tennessee Colored School in Center Texas. He thought some of the Bryants and Saulters might have attended. There was old man Wesley who was a Bryant. He had four children MT, John, Walter, and Robert in the 1900's. His first wife was Missouri Davis. Wesley Bryant had half brothers who were Thompsons. They were Harrison, Eziekie, and Bala. Also there was a Jim Bryant. Bala married a Carraway. Robert married Euretta Sautler. Her father was Osbie or Oscar Sautler. He remembered Sanford Bryant being murdered at Kyle's place in a dispute over the division of the crop. Sanford was working a "half a hand" on the Kyle Place. This was about 1929.

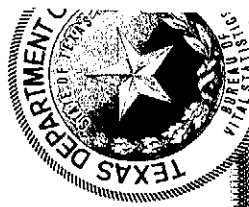

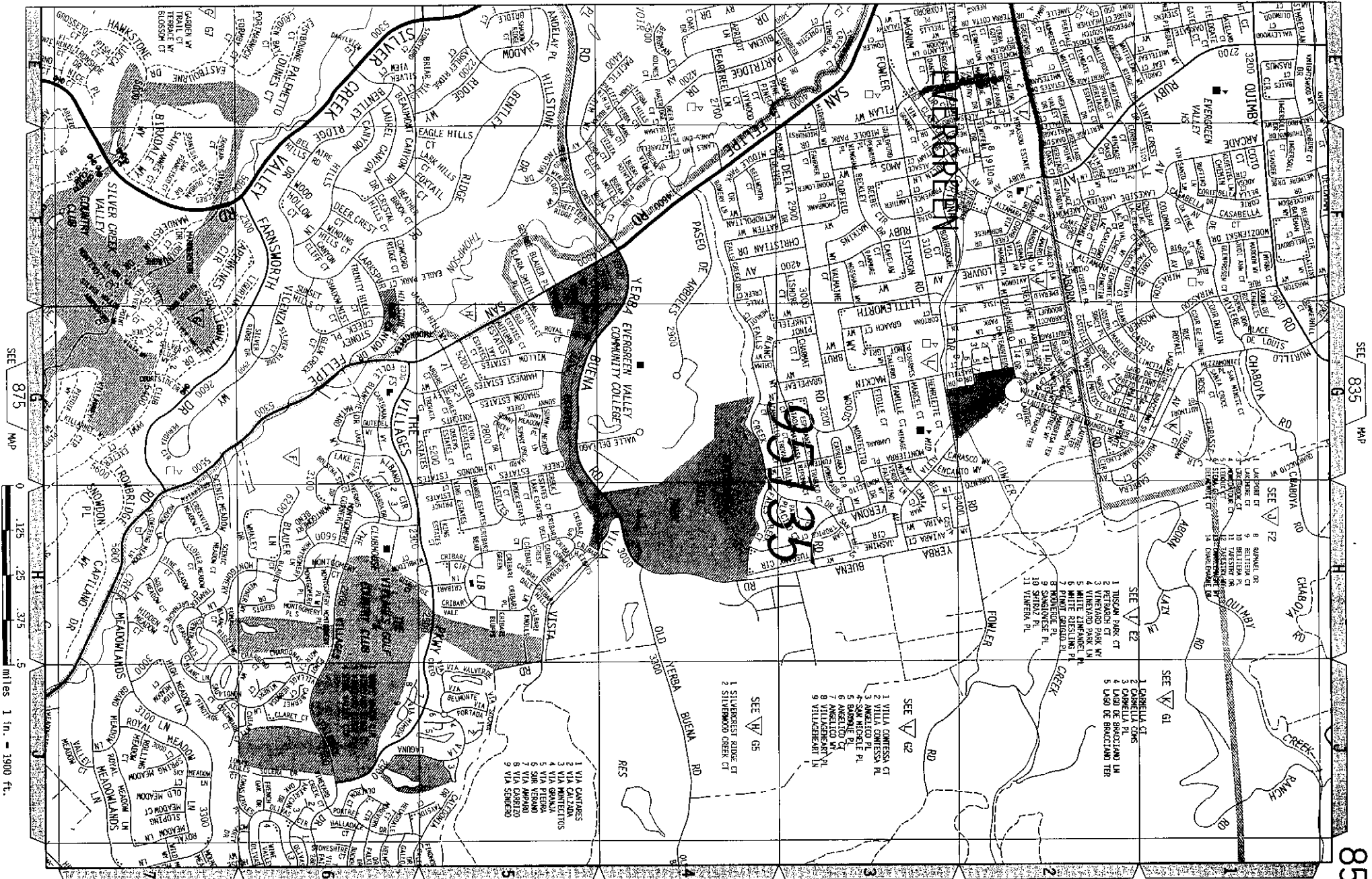
